

a network of hundreds of peace and justice organizations around the U.S. and the world. Together we work to end war and oppression, shift resources toward human needs, protect the environment, and promote sustainable alternatives. Our long-term goal is to grow a culture of justice, peace, equality, and cooperation. We value diversity and respect the earth. We encourage member groups and individuals to engage in a wide range of activities from educating the public and their elected representatives, to protests, street theater, nonviolent direct action and mass mobilization.



Ten Years of Working for Peace with Justice

UFPJ was founded in 2002, to oppose George Bush's Global War on Terror. On February 15, 2003 a UFPJ initiated call for global action at the World Social Forum resulted in 11 million people worldwide protesting war with Iraq. For ten years UFPJ has been a leader working for peace. After the 2008 economic crash and the rise of the Occupy movement, UFPJ organized into a network and began more work on the economy. UFPJ's vital programmatic work is carried out by our member groups and by volunteers leading working groups and campaigns. Go to our website to join a working group.

The Arab Spring, the Wisconsin Wave, the Occupy movement and other popular uprisings around the world bring hope for this next decade. Beyond War a New Economy is Possible

Many UFPJ member groups are working on campaigns to fund jobs, education and healthy communities by cutting the military budget. UFPJ collaborates with the New Priorities Network and other efforts to redirect military spending to human needs.

End the US War in Afghanistan

UFPJ's Afghanistan Working Group exposes the horrors and costs of over a decade of occupation and war.

We call for withdrawal of U.S./NATO forces and a negotiated, just settlement involving Afghans, neighboring countries and international parties.

Nuclear Abolition

The Nuclear Disarmament/Redefinina Security Working Group works to keep the issue of nuclear weapons at the forefront of our fight against militarism and empire, to expose the exorbitant financial costs and grave environmental dangers of the entire nuclear chain, and to highlight the links between nuclear energy and weapons.

Every August we observe "Nuclear-Free Future Month" to promote a world free of nuclear weapons and nuclear power.

The Legislative Working Group connects people and groups across the country to pressure Congress to end the wars and redirect military spending to domestic needs. Join the Legislative Working Group to receive information about bills currently before Congress, and to consider effective strategies and actions to shift US policies toward justice and peace.
